World Service Office Board Seeks Treasurer

Qualifications:

1. Should have prior Area or District, service committee Treasurer experience or professional experience in the fields of finance or accounting.

2. Responsible for supervising all financial matters at the WSO including:

a. Accounts payable, b. Accounts receivable, c. All bank accounts, d. Coordinates negotiations with vendors, e. Contacts outside accounting firms, f. Supervises all tax filings

2. Chairperson of the WSO Finance/Spending committee.

3. Supervises policies regarding financial matters.

4. Has prepared by outside firm of Certified Public Accountants quarterly financial statements for CAWSO Board and WSBT. In addition, prepare any additional reports or explanations to describe note worth changes or trends in the financial condition of CA World Services.

5. Sits on WSC Finance Committee.

Each CAWSO Board member shall serve a two-year term and be ratified no less than once per year at a meeting by each of the CAWSO Board and WSBT. The first term of each CAWSO Board member begins upon ratification by the WSBT and ends at the close of the third WSC.
